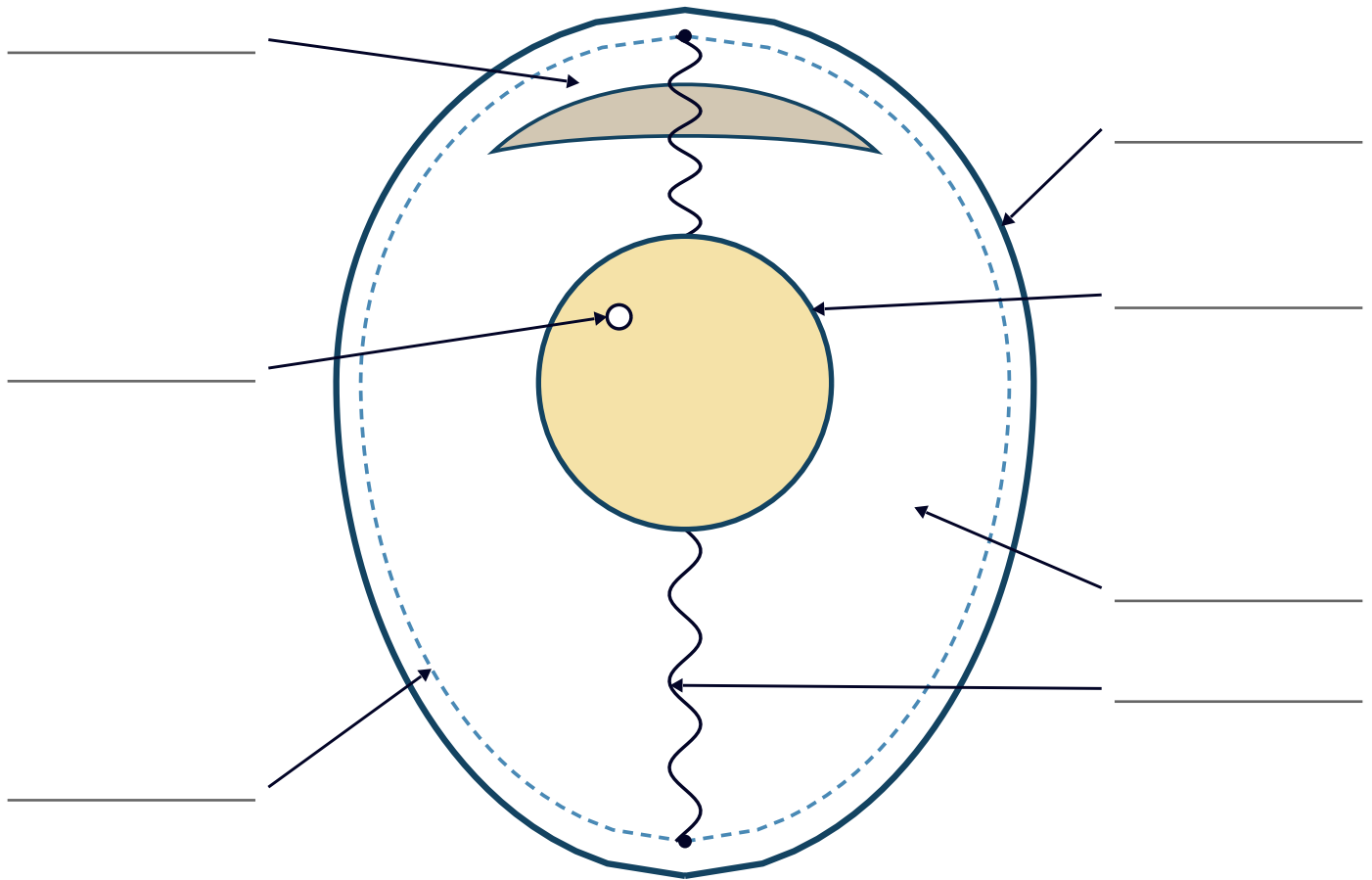


Magic Dust: Parts of an Egg

Label each part of the egg using the word bank below. Then use felt, paper, or playdough to build your own egg model!

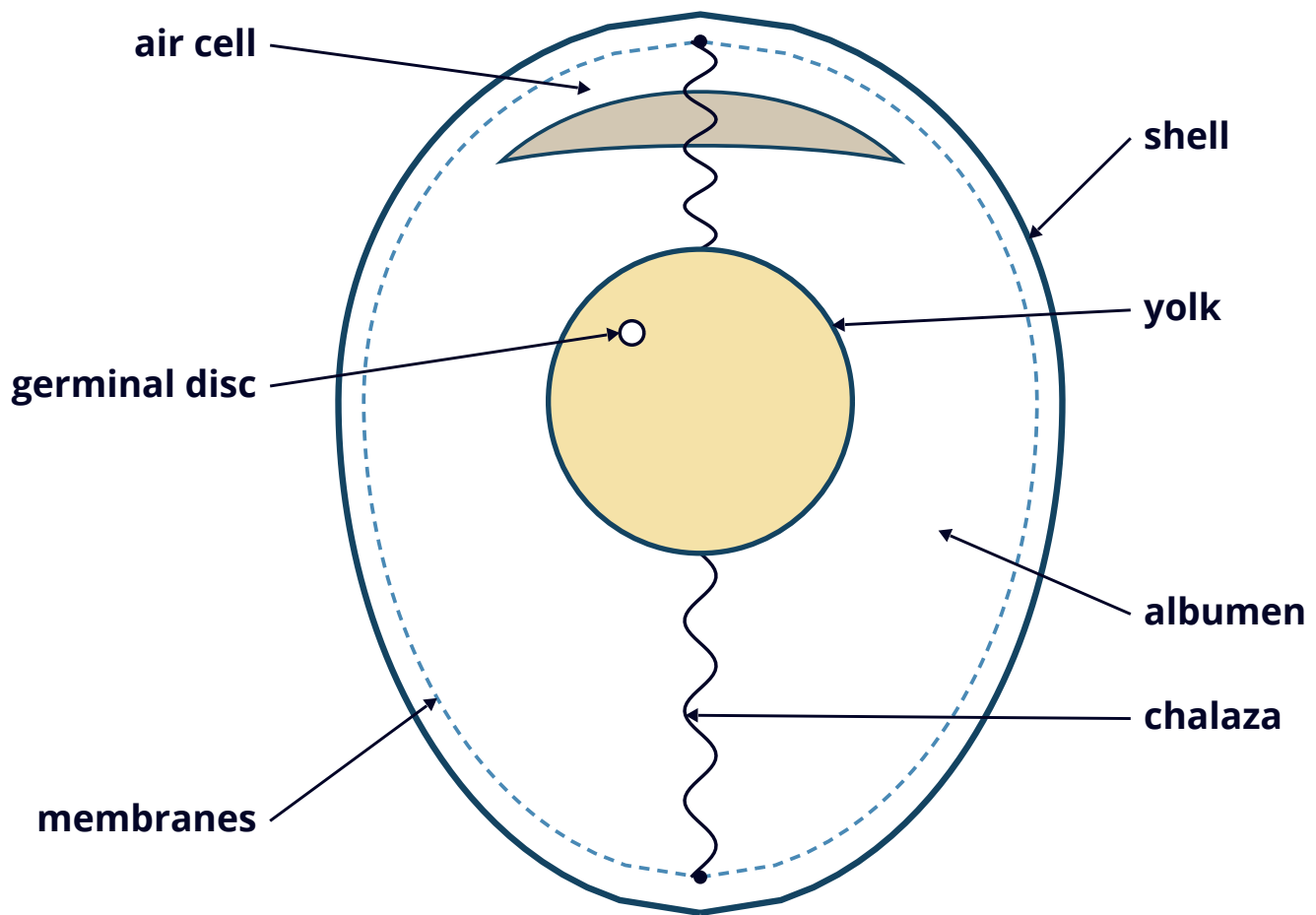

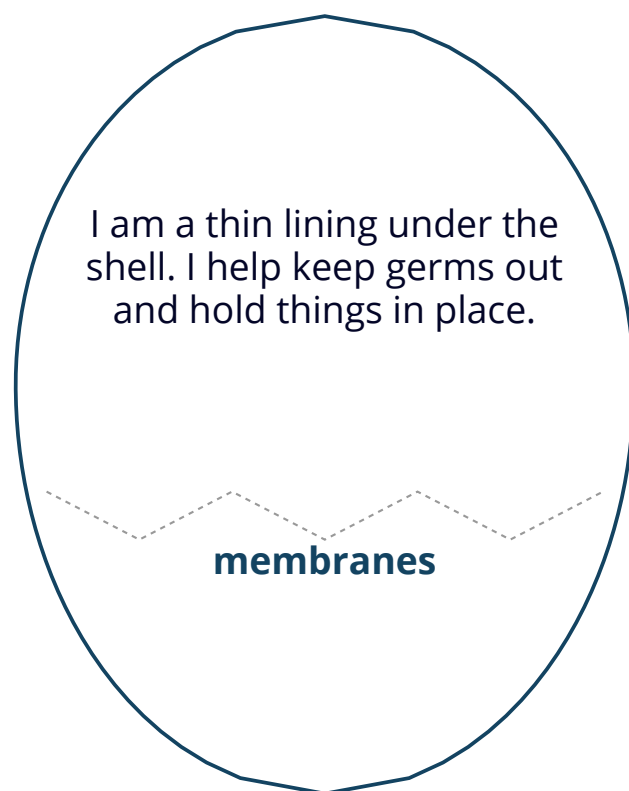
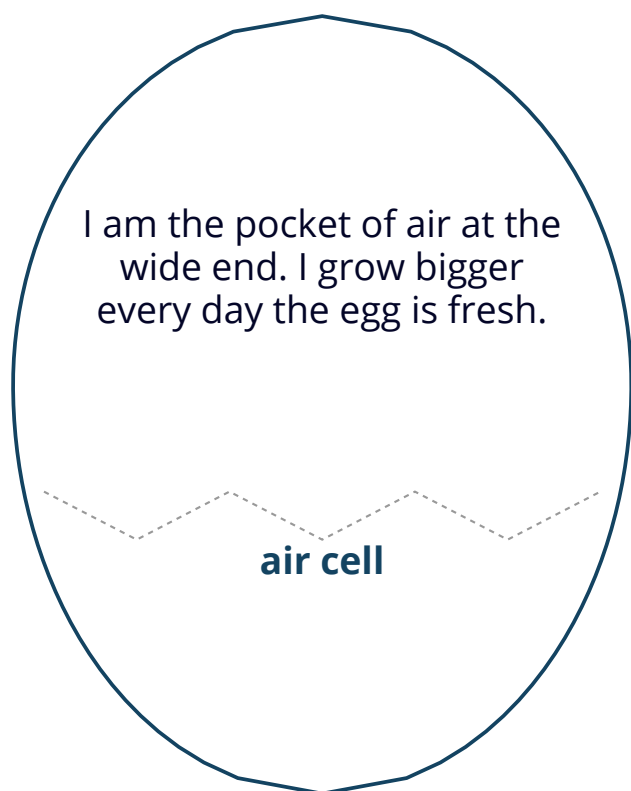
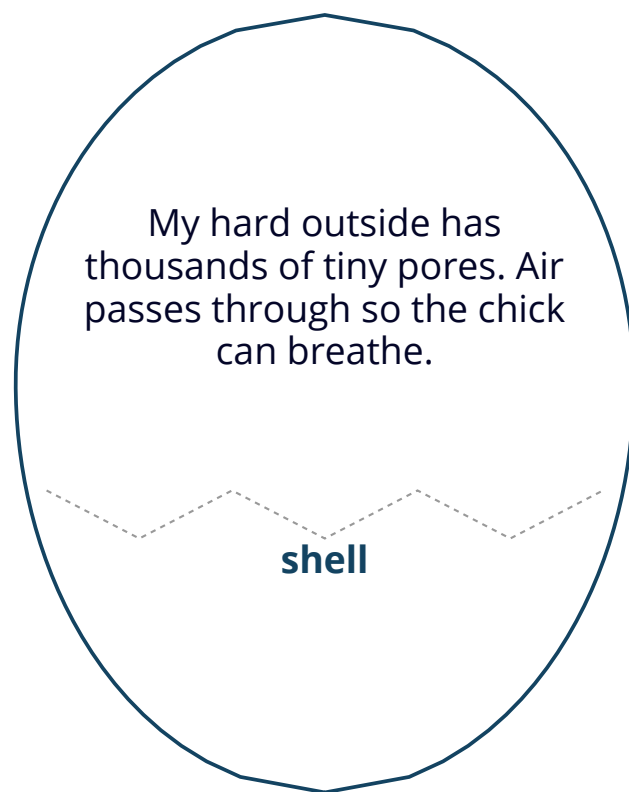
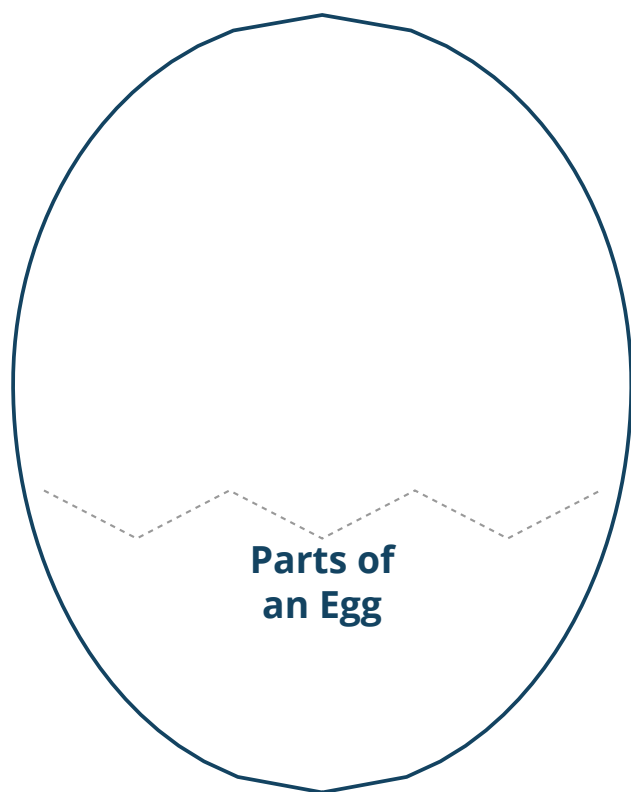
Magic Dust: Parts of an Egg

An egg holds everything a growing chick needs. Use this diagram as your answer key while you build the felt (or paper) egg model with your student.



Build Your Own Egg Book

Cut out each egg piece below. Stack them behind the cover and fasten with a brad so the pages flip like a little book!



Build Your Own Egg Book (continued)

Cut out the rest of the egg pieces below and add them to your book.

You know me as the egg white! I cushion the yolk and give the chick water and protein.

albumen

I am the golden ball in the center, packed with fat and nutrients for the growing chick.

yolk

I am a twisted rope of egg white. I anchor the yolk to the shell's lining so it stays centered.

chalaza

I am a tiny pale spot on the yolk. This is where a new chick begins to grow.
